### Monday's Schedule

**Free Time-** Where the children are free to play and explore in the classroom.

**Art & Literacy-** Practice writing Dd and gluing feathers on their letter. Each child electively can also make their own duck feet using fabric scissors.

**Circle Time** -Where we go over the Letter of the Day, and read our special Book of the Day: I Wish That I Had Duck Feet. We will also include some interactive fun facts about ducks within circle time!

**Cooking-** We will make the food that many people feed ducks, bread! We are making Roti, an unleavened bread originating from India. The kids will enjoy playing with the dough!

**Lunch** - Please be mindful we do have a student with a nut allergy so let us know if you packed anything with nuts in your child's lunch so we know at which table to place your child.

**Outside Play or Indoor Play** - (depending on weather)

**Music and Movement-** Duck, Duck, Goose; Pass the Pumpkin; and A Pumpkin Walk.

**Hide & Hunt-** Find the hidden rubber duckies. Incorporate a group math activity through counting the hidden items together.

**Snack-**Eat our Roti with a little honey.

**Closing Circle and Dismissal-** Sharing and possibly reading a little Halloween Story.
